Benefits of Digital Badging:

- Choice is built-in
- Multiliteracies utilized
- Gamifying learner exercises
- Students determine value in their learning process
- Micro-tasks
- Condensed instructional time maximized
- Skills, abilities and knowledge demonstration- 'evidence of qualifications/credentialing'
- Customizable to suit a collaborative or individual effort
- Differentiated process
- Useful for any content area
- Expanded audience: content created is a collective of contributions

Collaboration Elevates Creation / Contribution Elevates Engagement:

- Students as contributors: being apart of something (especially critical in remote/hybrid/distance learning)
- Overlapping domains of responsibility
- Engagement in learning
- Empowering students to own their learning
